## **Frequently Asked Questions**

What happens after I submit the application?

A shelter representative will contact you to determine what program will best suit your needs and the needs of your pet. An appointment will be given to you at the next available clinic at our shelter. Or, a voucher will be issued for you at a local participating veterinary clinic.

#### What will the cost be?

The cost for the spay/neuter of your pet are available on our website. Additional programs and services may also be available and should be discussed with the shelter representative.

What other costs will I have to pay? If you are utilizing one of the shelter clinics, the fee for the spay/neuter includes a rabies vaccination (if needed). Other optional services are available including heartworm/lyme testing (dogs), leukemia/aids testing (cats), distemper vaccine, fecal checks, and flea treatment. These services are optional and only available at the time of spay/neuter. Routine veterinary checkups at your veterinarian are recommended and this program should not be considered a replacement for routine veterinary care.

How long does it take to get an appointment?

This depends on the bookings of the clinics. Every effort is made to get your pet in as soon as possible.

Spay/Neuter Programs Offered by Second Chance Animal Shelter

*Spay and Save program*- provides spay/neuter care for friendly stray and house cats to help prevent overpopulation. *SPOT Voucher Program* – provides low-cost spay/neuter assistance at local participating veterinary clinics.

*Feral Spay and Save Program –* provides low-cost spay/neuter assistance to deal with feral (wild) cat colonies and barn cats.

*Feral Spay Sunday* – is hosted at Second Chance twice a year in conjunction with the Dakin Pioneer Valley Animal Shelter. This program provides free care (donations appreciated) to feral (wild) cats and barn cats.

Helping Hands Clinic Program – provides spay/neuter assistance to local animal control and rescues to ensure all pets are spayed/neutered before adoption.
